



ADMISSION CRITERIA

RiverVista is a behavioral health hospital, serving the adult and senior populations in a contemporary healing environment. We specialize in providing care to those struggling with mental illness, behavioral issues, emotional distress and co-occurring substance use issues.

The determination for admission is determined based upon an individual case review following the initial evaluation to determine the most appropriate level of care. The initial evaluation is performed by a qualified mental health professional. The assessment will include:

- An initial evaluation by a RiverVista Physician who will review medical, emotional, behavioral, social, and nutritional needs.
- A review of the patient's psychiatric history, physical and health screenings and an evaluation of their current circumstances, stressors, presentation and symptomatology.

Admission is approved for patients who have a diagnosed psychiatric disorder and who are in need immediate intervention to avoid 1) life threatening health risks due to their mental disorder, and/or 2) imminent and severe damage to their social, occupational, education, financial or legal functioning due to symptoms of their mental disorder.

Our admission staff is available by call or walk-in 24/7. Our team of professionals is led by a psychiatrist. Together we work to obtain essential information to determine if you or your loved one meets the medical criteria necessary for our inpatient care.
