



ADMISSION CRITERIA

RiverVista is a behavioral health hospital, serving the adult and senior populations in a contemporary healing environment. The determination for admission is based upon an initial assessment by a qualified treatment professional. This assessment will include:

- Review of medical, emotional, behavioral, social and nutritional needs.
- A thorough review and evaluation of the patient's psychiatric history, including previous treatment and physical and health screenings.

Admission is approved for patients who have a diagnosed psychiatric disorder and who are in need of an immediate intervention to avoid 1) life threatening health risks due to their mental disorder, and/or 2) imminent and severe damage to their social, occupational, educational, financial or legal functioning due to symptoms of their mental disorder.
